



## BARN RULES

**Rules will be strictly enforced for rider and horse safety. Rule breakers are subject to loss of riding privileges or other disciplinary measures for repeated violations.**

1. BARN HOURS: Monday-Sunday, 8AM-8PM
2. Zero Tolerance Drama Policy: We will treat one another and our animals with respect and kindness, regardless of any differences.
3. Liability Release: All riders or persons on Alaska Youth Equestrian Club, LLC property, owned and operated by Crystal and William Borstad, must sign a liability release before riding and/or boarding any horses in any way. Boarders are responsible for having guests sign liability releases, which are available in the tack room. Minors need a note from parent/guardian granting permission to ride private horse(s) housed at Alaska Youth Equestrian Club, LLC property.
4. Approved Helmet: All riders under 18 years old MUST wear a helmet while mounting, riding, and dismounting a horse. Helmets are highly encouraged for all riders.
5. Dogs: No dogs allowed on premises without approval from landowners.
6. Gates and Doors: Must be shut after you go through them. Never leave them open, always latch the gate after you. If you are the last one at the barn, make sure lights are off and doors are shut.
7. Children 14 and under: Must be supervised by an adult.
8. Feed rooms and tack spaces: are off limits to ALL visitors, unless you are accompanied by a boarder or staff member(s). Please do not touch any feed that is not your own.
9. No Horses turned out, or free lunged in the arena while someone else is using the arena or intending too.
10. Clean up after yourself: There are trash cans, manure forks and muck buckets available for disposal of manure, shed hair, hay, and general use in the feed room and barn.
11. Please leave things: how you found them. If you're the last person out, turn off the lights.



12. Cleaning up: Boarders MUST clean their stalls everyday! Leasers must follow their contracts of what their chores are without fail.

13. Any accident or injury to a person or horse must be reported immediately to management, and an incident form must be filled out.

14. IF: someone does something clearly wrong AND it is a safety issue/hazard let the barn manager and owner know. Don't confront the person unless a horse or person is in immediate danger.

15. Follow all rules: In your board, lease, lesson paperwork, ALL rules must be followed and completed.

16. DO NOT FEED, RIDE, HANDLE OR MEDICATE ANOTHER BOARDERS' HORSE WITHOUT WRITTEN PERMISSION OF THAT HORSES' OWNER, PROVIDED TO MANAGER/OWNER, DISREGARD OF THIS RULE IS GROUNDS FOR EVICTION.

17. IF you don't do it at home: don't do it here! Use common sense and courtesy at all times, please!
